

# NDC Re-Accreditation

Possums & Co. requires NDC practitioners to undertake re-accreditation every two years to maintain competency and clinical knowledge. This re-accreditation process aims to ensure that those health professionals identifying as NDC Accredited Practitioners and using our parent handouts and other resources are providing high quality care in a way which aligns with the NDC programs, which may change as the evidence develops.

Re-accreditation process provides a supportive and high-quality evidence-based programme that promotes flexibility to suit your professional and personal circumstances, to ensure your passion and commitment to the NDC programme continues.

The re-accreditation program is completed over two years and involves NDC practitioners accruing **20 points** during this period.

These 20 points should be comprised of **10 points** annually, including at least **5 points** for mandatory activities (as outlined below). The remaining points can be made up by mandatory or elective activities.
